- Draft Sediment and E.Coli TMDL – Overview of Draft TMDL- Hawk Stone:

Discussion of Draft TMDL 5 significant changes:

- We changed the focus of the target. The target itself is the same as before: SEV 8 from Newcombe and Jensen.
Previously we used 4 months as the pollutant duration for every stream. This new version takes a more nuanced approach. Specifically, the monitoring data showed that durations of 84 and 92 days were more appropriate for certain streams. We also changed the assemblage structure for a couple of streams higher in the watershed (appendix F).
- We included 3 new assessment units in the TMDL:
 - Sand Creek/Stewart Gulch was found to be impaired by E. coli this summer.
 - Indian Creek out in the desert, and upstream of Indian Creek Reservoir is a legacy sediment impairment.

These additions ensure that we address *all* of the sediment and E. coli listings in the watershed.

 - We added a short section on the attainability of existing and designated uses (pages 29-31).
 - We referenced the Nampa Meridian Irrigation District's historic and hydrologic reports (appendices I and J).
