The Idaho Department of Environmental Quality (Department) received a Permit by Rule Registration form for a Nonmetallic Mineral Processing Plant from Salmon River Sand and Gravel on October 11, 2001. The registration is for the following equipment:

Pioneer Crusher
Serial Number: 158
Capacity: 60 tons per hour

Pioneer Screen
Serial Number: 3741

Stanford Generator
60 kW Diesel-fired

The Department sent a letter, certified mail, on October 31, 2001, to notify you that your registration for permit by rule is registered in our files. The letter was returned on November 27, 2001. The Department is sending this letter, uncertified, in an attempt to inform you that your permit by rule registration has been received and processed.

There is no existing air quality permit associated with this company; therefore, no termination action is required. We recommend that you maintain a copy of this letter and a copy of the enclosed registration form for your records.

Please be advised that the registered equipment must comply with the Rules for the Control of Nonmetallic Mineral Processing Plants in accordance with IDAPA 58.01.01.790 through 802 (*Rules for the Control of Air Pollution in Idaho*). 

If your crushing plant is portable, you will be required to submit a portable equipment relocation form each time the plant is moved to a new site of operations. This form is required to be submitted to the Department ten days prior to relocating the equipment. A copy of the form is enclosed for your convenience.
