## **Important Dates for Public Drinking Water Operators/Owners**

<b>CCR</b> ( <b>Consumer Confidence Report</b> ) <b>Sampling/Wholesale Data.</b> CCR sampling and violation histories available from DEQ annually around <b>mid-March</b> . ( <i>Community systems</i> )
<b>CCR - Wholesale Systems. April 1</b> is the final date for wholesale systems to provide sample and violations data to purchasing systems. ( <i>Community systems</i> )
CCR Report Due. By July 1 of each year for all community water systems. (Community systems)
<b>CCR Certification.</b> October 1 (or within 90 days of distribution, whichever is first) is the final date to submit a CCR Certification Completion form to DEQ regional offices. ( <i>Community systems</i> )
<b>Monitoring Schedules. Monthly</b> review of sample monitoring schedules. (All public water systems)
<b>Monitoring Waiver Requests.</b> Due prior to the <b>end of a 3-Year monitoring period</b> . ( <i>Community and Non-community Non-transient systems</i> )
Sample Results. Sample results due to DEQ no later than the 10th day of the following month in which the sampling was completed. (All public water systems)
Annual Fee Assessments Mailed. September 1. (All public water systems)
Annual Fee Assessments Due. Annual drinking water fee assessments are due October 1, but not past due until November 1. Some payments are due on a monthly or quarterly basis. (All public water systems)
<b>Backflow Prevention Assemblies Testing.</b> Backflow prevention devices inspections and testing due <b>annually</b> based on date of last testing. ( <i>All public water systems</i> )
Loan and Grant Applications. (Community and Non-community Non-transient systems)  October to mid January – DEQ accepting Letters of Interest for grants and loans for upcoming year's priority lists.  May – DEQ Board adopts priority lists for upcoming year.  May – Notices sent to Letter of Interest submitters, informing them of availability of funds for upcoming year for their project.  July 1 – beginning of period covered by priority list (first opportunity to enter into new loans/grants).  June 30 (of the following year) – end of period covered by priority list (last opportunity to enter into new loans/grants).
<b>Enhanced Sanitary Surveys (ESS) Due.</b> Check and prepare for ESSs based on a <b>three or five-year basis.</b> (All public water systems)
Public Notification Deadlines. (All public water systems) Tier 1 - 24 hours Tier 2 - 30 days Tier 3 -12 months
Operator Annual License Renewal. Operator licenses must be renewed annually, which come due each year on the operator's birthday. (Community and Non-community Non-transient systems)

October	Annual Fee Assessments: due October 1. (All public water systems)
	<b>Loans and Grants:</b> DEQ accepting Letters of Interest for loans and grants through mid January. (Community and Non-community Non-transient systems)
	<b>CCR:</b> CCR certification due October 1 (or within 90 days of distribution, whichever is first) to DEQ regional offices. ( <i>Community systems</i> )
	Monitoring waiver requests due. (Community and Non-community Non-transient systems)
November	Annual Fee Assessments: past due November 1. (All public water systems)
December	Regular day-to-day public water system operations. (All public water systems)
