Mary Grace Pawson, a registered civil engineer and senior project manager with GHD, an international network of planners and engineers with a strong focus on integrated water planning. Ms. Pawson has broad background in project planning and project development for public agencies including work on recycled water master plans, urban water management plans, water supply assessments, integrated regional water management plans, grant-writing, and rate and fee setting.

Ms. Pawson also serves on the California Section of the WateReuse Association's Board of Trustees and chairs the Section's Legislative and Regulatory Committee. In this role she has coordinated Section's work on a number of legislative and regulatory initiatives related to recycled water use including coordinating a groundbreaking stakeholder negotiation which resulted in an updated of the State's recycled water policy. She is currently working with Assembly member Hueso's office on the development of AB 2398 (a bill sponsored by the WateReuse Association), which will provide a comprehensive update of California's statutory framework for recycled water. Ms. Pawson has been recognized as a "Water Leader" by the Association of California Water Agencies and has received a President's Award from WateReuse.
