Table 2. Permit Limits and Conditions

Parameter	Permit Conditions
Public Health Hazard or Nuisance Condition	Activities covered under this permit must not create a public health hazard or nuisance condition, as stated in the <i>Wastewater Rules</i> , IDAPA 58.01.16.600.03.
Groundwater	The activities covered under this permit shall not cause a violation of the <i>Ground Water Quality Rule</i> , IDAPA 58.01.11.
Surface Water	The activities covered under this permit shall not cause a violation of the water quality standards in the <i>Water Quality Standards</i> , IDAPA 58.01.02.
Entry and Access	The permittee shall allow DEQ entry and access to inspect the facility in accordance with the <i>Recycled Water Rules</i> , IDAPA 58.01.17.500.05.
Reporting	The permittee shall report changes, non-compliances and other relevant facts in accordance with the <i>Recycled Water Rules</i> , IDAPA 58.01.17.500.06.
Condition no. 1	The facility shall maintain a log of the following: the date, volume, and type of raw feed stock (ex. sawdust spent block or straw) addition, annual recycled water volume, and the date and volume of finished compost removed from the site.
Condition no. 2	Recycled water is only permitted for composting. Any additional uses of recycled water must be approved by DEQ in writing in advance.
Condition no. 3	Recycled water may only be applied to Groves Country Farms property. Buffer distances shown in Table 3 shall be maintained.
Recordkeeping	An Annual Operational Summary documenting compliance with permit conditions no. 1, 2, and 3 shall submitted along with the annual certification, including any supporting documents used to demonstrate compliance. The Annual Operational Summary documents shall be maintained on site for a minimum of 5 years from the date of each annual certification.

Groves Country Farms, LLC (hereafter “permittee”) is hereby authorized to construct, install, and operate a reuse facility in accordance with (1) this permit; and (2) IDAPA 58.01.17 “Recycled Water Rules.” To maintain this permit, the responsible official for the permittee must sign and certify annually in writing that the facility operation and conditions upon which this permit was granted have not changed, including the basis for that assessment.
